

Plovput in Numbers

- Established in 1963
- Managing 963 km of international IWWs (Danube, Sava, and Tisza)
- Over 500 managed projects so far







Plovput in Numbers

- **101** employees
- Fleet of 18 vessels
- Annual budget of EUR 1.7 Million (2012)

- Law on Ministries (2007, 2008)
- Plovput is a special organization of the Government of the Republic of Serbia
- Law on Navigation and Ports on IWWs (2010)









Mission Statement


 Our mission is to provide efficient, sustainable, standardized and environmentally friendly system of inland waterways which will be used by businesses and general public at local and international scale






